

# Bias suit calls city building a heil-rise

A security supervisor is suing the manager of a [Manhattan](#) high-rise for greeting him with a "Heil Hitler" salute and bragging that he ran the building like a "plantation."

Security supervisor [Godfrey Williams](#) makes the claims in a racial discrimination suit filed yesterday in [Manhattan Federal Court](#) against Mulligan Security and Monday Properties.

Williams says he was fired in June 2007 after complaining to higher-ups about racial comments made by property manager [Wayne Kohlbrecher](#).

The suit says Kohlbrecher reacted angrily in March 2006 when an Asian security guard who worked for Williams asked for a raise.

Williams said Kohlbrecher was angry that Williams didn't handle it himself.

"This is why you are here," he says Kohlbrecher told him. The suit says Kohlbrecher then used a string of racial slurs to describe blacks and Hispanics.

Kohlbrecher bragged that he managed the 25-story building at 1440 Broadway like a plantation, the suit says. The [Times Square](#) building counts [Google](#), [Liz Claiborne](#) and others as tenants.

"I can crack a mean whip," the suit quotes Kohlbrecher as saying. "I can cut the flesh from bone. ... I like the smell of flesh."

Williams, of [Brooklyn](#), worked at the Broadway location from 2003 until he was fired. Monday Properties called Williams' claims "completely unfounded and untrue."
